## FOUNDATION FUNDING FOR U.S. TRANS COMMUNITIES

THE NEED
Despite limited data on trans people and their experiences, it is estimated that there are more than 1 million "out" trans people living all across the United States. estimated u.s. Adult population identifying as transgender, 2016 ${ }^{1}$

On account of persistent workplace arassment, discrimination, and biased exminations, transgender people often leads to homelessness. Transgender people are nearly four times more likely to be living on less than $\$ 10,000$ than the general population.

All too often, healthcare professionals and insurance companies lack the appropriate cultural competency to adequately treat trans people. One in 3 trans people report having at least one negative experience, such as verbal harassment, refusal of treatment, or
having to teach the healthcare provider about transgender people to receive appropriate care.

A number of social determinants drive alarming health disparities for trans people. Nearly one in five black transgender women are living with HIV/AIDS.

THE FONDDNG

Foundation funding for trans communities has continued to increase
dramatically since we released Transformational Impact: Foundation Funding or Trans Communities in 2015. In the past five years alone, the funding increased more than four fold.

However, for every $\$ 100$ awarded by U.S. Foundations, less than 3 cents benefits trans communities.
